## PARKING PROCEDURES

Parking on 21st Street will not begin until about 6:50 am.

Vehicles will enter 21st Street from Bryan Avenue, and will be directed to a parking space by the market manager.

Ten foot spaces will be marked off on the roadway for each vehicle to park between.

Move your vehicles forward until they either touch a curb or the edge of the grass.

You must be in a parking space prior to 8:00 am. From 8:00 am until 12:00 pm, the area in the middle of 21st Street will become a pedestrian walkway. No vehicles will be allowed in or out of that area during that four hour time period.

If you arrive after 8:00 am, if you are planning to leave early, or if all spaces on 21st Street are full, you will be directed to park parallel to the curb on Bryan Avenue, just past its intersection with 21st Street.

When parking on Bryan Avenue, pull as close to the curb as possible, leaving enough space between vehicles to set up your canopy and allow shoppers room to get to your product. Place your canopies so that they extend no further than one foot beyond the left side of your vehicle.

For the safety of our shoppers, vehicles parked on 21st Street will not be allowed to leave before 12:00 pm.

Main Street parking is for the convenience of our customers. If you come in two vehicles, the second vehicle can park on Main Street or Bryan Avenue to unload their product and move it to their setup location. After unloading, those vehicles must be moved to the blocked off section of 21st Street, east of Main Street. This section of 21st Street can be accessed by going south on Main Street and turning left on 21st Street, there will be an alley on the left that will take you to the blocked section of 21st Street.

Vendors pulling trailers will either park on Bryan Avenue or on the blocked off portion of 21st Street, east of Main Street
